

BEO takes action against Amita Shiksha Niketan

- Ensures compliance with standards

Gaurela- Pendra-Marwahi, Mar 14: In a commendable move toward ensuring quality education, the Block Education Officer of Gaurela took swift action against Amita Shiksha Niketan, Pendarao, for failing to adhere to government regulations.

The school, found to be operating in a negligent and arbitrary manner, there is no library, lab, playground in the school, and was issued a notice for its disregard of prescribed norms.

During a thorough inspection, it was revealed that the school was over-crowded, with more children than the designated



capacity crammed into small rooms.

The students in various classes are 58 in Nursery, 57 in LKG, 51 in UKG, 54 in 1st, 51 in 2nd, 48 in 3rd, 47 in 4th, 40 in 5th, 39 in 6th, 46 in 7th, 38 in 8th, 40 in 9th and in 10th 26. Shockingly, 595 children were found sitting in inadequate spaces, highlighting a blatant disregard for the well-

being of students.

Furthermore, the lack of essential facilities such as a library, laboratory, and playground, coupled with unhygienic conditions and insufficient eating areas, raised serious concerns about the school's commitment to providing a conducive learning environment.

Block Education Officer

Gaurela, Dr. Sanjeev Shukla, demonstrated firm resolve by promptly issuing a notice to the school's principal, urging a response within two days. This decisive action underscores the government's dedication to upholding educational standards and ensuring the welfare of students across the region.

Patwari suspended failing to give satisfactory reply

Simga, Mar 14: The Patwari Amit Kumar Sahu of Patwari H.No. 22 RI Mandal Chapora, Tehsil Tilda-Newara, District Raipur was issued a show-cause notice for violation of acting against the Chhattisgarh Civil Service Code Rule 1965 and in violation of instructions under part-2 of Annexure of Chhattisgarh Land Records Rules. So now the additional charge of this Patwari H. No. 22 has been given to Patwari Yogendra Parginha of Patwari H. No. 23 and he would look after both the P.H. No.s and Amit Kumar Sahu would be paid honourarium as per the rule book.

Dhamtari, Mar 14: As per instructions by the SP Dhamtari for taking strict action against the illicit sale of liquor, its transportation and selling of dungs and other anti-social elements, the Arjuni Thana TI got tip from an informer that a person is taking crop of 'Ganja' in his backyard. Based upon the information, TI Thana Arjuni went to the residence of accused Ashwini Kumar Sahu and found that he has taken 'Ganja' crop in his backyard. Bijapur, Mar 14: On March 11, on the intelligence of the presence of Maoists of Bhairamgarh Area Committee in the forest of Bodga, a joint team of DRG and STF had gone towards Bodga, Takild, Uspari.

An encounter took place between police and Maoists in the forests of Bodga at around 15.00 pm on 12/03/2024. After searching the incident

site, a huge quantity of explosive material, Naxal literature and other daily useful materials were recovered from the incident site. Bodga resident Raje Oyam, age 44, was shot in the cross firing between police and Maoists.

Information was also received that some Maoist members of Bhairamgarh Area Committee were injured in the encounter. Searching is being done by the police force in the surrounding area.
