# BJP MP Hema Malini Meets UP CM Yogi Adityanath In Lucknow

Lucknow: Member of Parliament from Mathura, Hema Malini, paid a cour-tesy visit to Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath at his official residence in Lucknow on Saturday, Earlier in the day, BJP MP Malini expressed concern over the recent terror attack in Pahalgam, Jammu and Kashmir, stat-ing that the nation is deeply disturbed by the incident.

She said the Prime

She said the Prime Minister is expected to respond to the incident, and the government is investigating the matter. Speaking to ANI, Malini said, "The attack that happened in Pahalgam is very bad, we can never imagine that this can happen, the whole country is pen, the whole country is



upset. Our government is investigating this thoroughly, our Prime Minister will give a reply to this, he will definitely do something about this..."

Twenty-six people were killed in the terror attack in Baisaran meadow in Pahalgam, Jammu and Kashmir, on Tuesday.

India has taken strong countermeasures against Pakistan for its support of cross-border terrorism.

The government has temporarily suspended the Indus Waters Treaty with Pakistan. This decision was made at a meeting of the Cabinet Committee on

Security (CCS) held on April 23, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, and attended by Home Minister Amit Shah, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, and External Affairs Minister S, Jaishankar.

Meanwhile, fear and panic have gripped Kashmir istudents across the country following open threats and targeted violence in the aftermath of the Pahalgam terror attack.

### Five Omani Nationals Found Staying Illegally At Hotel, Lucknow Under High Alert

Lucknow. In Lucknow, security agencies have launched an investigation after five Omani nationals were found staying illegally at a hotel in the city's Gomti Nagar area on Saturday. The individuals were

discovered without any prior notification to the authorities. According to police, the hotel owner failed to submit the man-datory C-Form and did not inform the Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRRO)

During initial questioning, the foreign nationals were unable to provide a valid reason for their stay in the country. Their travel documents have been seized for verification.

A case has been registered against the hotel owner and manager, and an intelligence probe is now underway. Authorities have intensified surveillance and security checks across key loca-tions in the city as a pre-cautionary measure. Fur-ther details are awaited as the investigation

investigation progresses. On Friday, Joint Commissioner of Police (Law and Order) Lucknow, Babloo Kumar said that five out of eight Pakistani nationals who had entered India on short-term visas have been sent back as per instructions issued by the Union government.

Speaking to reporters, JCP Kumar said, "As per the Govt of India's instruction, among eight

people who had come to India (from Pakistan) on a visa, 5 have been sent back. Rest 3 have been in-structed to go back to Pa-kistan within today and to-morrow. We are keeping an eye on other people." He further clarified that all eight individuals

that all eight individuals had entered the country on short-term visas. "All these eight people have come on a short-term visa," he said. Union Home Minis-



ter Amit Shah is also in touch with all chief ministers on the issue, asking them to identify all Pakistani nationals in their respective states and take steps to ensure their prompt return to Pakistan.
